

**YGSA ANNUAL GIRLS FASTPITCH SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT**  
**JUNE 12-13, 2010**  
**SERTOMA PARK AND RIVERSIDE PARK**

- \* Divisions – U10, U12, U14, U16 & U18. (Pending on the number of teams that sign up. Divisions may be combined)
- \* FOUR GAME GUARANTEE – Pool play (Sat.) will determine seeding into single elimination tournament (Sun).
- \* Individual medals and team plaques awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place in each division.
- \* Jerry Shelburg Sportsmanship Award given to one team for the weekend.
- \* ASA rules apply (Run rule – 12 after 3<sup>rd</sup> inning, 8 after 5<sup>th</sup> inning) (Open substitution on Sat.).
- \* Travel Permits required for Minnesota & North Dakota teams.
- \* Time Limit – 1 hour 15 minutes for all games (pool play games may end in a tie).
- \* Have line up cards completed and be ready to play at scheduled time.
- \* Umpires' decisions are final. No protests. Coaches are responsible for player and fan behavior.
- \* Coin flip prior to game time determines home team. Home team is official scorekeeper.
- \* Three ASA pickup players are allowed – names must be on team roster.
- \* Birth certificates must be available for all players if anyone questions the age of a player.
- \* A player's name and/or picture may be used on the YGSA website or in the newspaper.
- \* Managers – please turn in team roster (print off of the website) and travel papers (if necessary) at tournament headquarters before first game. Please have your ASA registration card available. Pick up coach passes at tournament headquarters.
- \* Tournament director also reserves the right to change tournament format.
- \* Admission will be \$3.00 per day per person. Ages 12 and under admitted free.
- \* Concessions are available at the complex.
- \* All coolers must remain within the parking area.
- \* Coaches Passes required.
